

With a global network of trade offices, the agency fosters bilateral business relations and actively promotes Poland as a competitive destination for business, innovation, and industry.




CAMBRIDGE INNOVATION CENTER

As part of this event, a special integration activity will take place during the program.






KOZMINSKI UNIVERSITY
